

CTT National 50 championship Sunday 2nd July Writtle University College CM1 3RR

Southend Wheelers are celebrating our 100th year by promoting the Cycling Time Trials National 50-mile time trial championship on Sunday 2nd July in Chelmsford. It will incorporate our annual Norman Wells 50-mile time trial event. The Norman Wells Trophy has been raced for since 1964, but our first open 50 was in 1926.

The Race HQ will be at Writtle University College (motto: Time Tries the Truth in Everything), and the imposing façade of the University, and the lawn at the front allows us to have a TT village, with exhibitors taking gazebo space, and riders and teams also allocated warm up space on the lawns.

We will be inviting former RTTC/CTT National 50-mile champions and record holder, and winners of the Norman Wells 50s to the event for fans to meet, with broadcaster and journalist Michael Hutchinson as the MC & host for the morning, who will announce the medal winners and the women's and men's individual and team champions.

First rider starts at 7:00hrs but we need to gauge the entry before we announce the time of the presentation of awards.
